NOTES TO THE FORM OF PROXY

- 1
- Before completing this Form of Proxy, please also read "Action to be Taken" set out on pages 10 to 14 of the scheme document that accompanied this Form of Proxy ("Scheme Document"). Save where otherwise defined herein, capitalised terms and expressions used in this Form of Proxy shall have the meanings given to them in the Scheme Document.
- 2
- Only Voting Scheme Shareholders, or their duly appointed representatives, are entitled to attend, speak and vote at the Court Meeting. A Voting Scheme Shareholder may appoint one or more proxies (provided that each proxy is appointed to exercise rights attached to a different Voting Scheme Share or Voting Scheme Shares), who need not be Voting Scheme Shareholders, to exercise all or any of their rights to attend, speak and vote on their behalf. Proxies may only be appointed using the procedures set out in this Form of Proxy. If you do not wish to appoint the Chairman of the Court Meeting as your proxy, add in block capitals the name of your chosen proxy in the box provided. If this box is left blank, the Chairman of the Court Meeting will be your proxy. If the proxy is being appointed in relation to less than your full voting entitlement, please enter in the box provided the number of Voting Scheme Shares in relation to which they are authorised to act as your proxy. If this box is left blank, your proxy will be deemed to be authorised in respect of your full voting entitlement (or, if this Form of Proxy has been issued in respect of a designated account for a Voting Scheme Shareholder, the full voting entitlement for that designated account). The Form of Proxy gives your proxy/ies full rights to attend, speak and vote. If you wish to restrict the rights of your proxy/ies, please cross out either or both of the words 'speak' or 'vote' as you feel appropriate. Any proxy appointed pursuant to this Form of Proxy will vote as indicated by this Form of Proxy on the Scheme. For any other business arising at the Court Meeting (including any procedural motion or resolution not listed in the notice of the Court Meeting) the proxy appointed pursuant to this Form of Proxy will vote at their sole discretion

- This Form of Proxy (i) in the case of an individual, must either be signed by the appointor or their attorney; and (ii) in the case of a corporation, must be either given under its common seal or be signed on its behalf by an attorney or a duly authorised officer of the corporation. Any signature on, or authentication of, such appointment need not be witnessed. Where an appointment of a proxy is signed on behalf of the appointor by an attorney, the power of attorney or a copy thereof certified notarially or in some other way approved by the Directors of the Company must (failing previous registration with the Company) be submitted to the Company, failing which the appointment may be treated as invalid.

- The appointment of a proxy will not prevent a Voting Scheme Shareholder from subsequently attending and voting at the Court Meeting in person should they decide to do so. All Voting Scheme Shareholders are entitled to attend and vote at the Court Meeting, whether or not they have returned a Form of Proxy.

- To be valid, the Form of Proxy, and any power of attorney or other authority under which it is executed (or a duly certified copy of any such power or authority), must either be sent by post to the Registrar, Neville Registrars, Neville House, Steelpark Road, Halesowen, B62 8HD or (for uncertificated holders only) lodged using the CREST electronic proxy appointment service (CREST ID: 7RA11) in accordance with the procedures set out in the CREST Manual, in each case, so as to arrive no later than 10:00 a.m. (London, UK time) on 10 November 2025 or, if the Court Meeting is adjourned, 48 hours before the time fixed for the adjourned Court Meeting. If the Form of Proxy is not returned by the specified time, it may be handed to a representative of the Registrar on behalf of the Chairman of the Court Meeting at the Court Meeting before the start of the Court Meeting. A proxy appointment sent by CREST may be treated as invalid in the circumstances set out in Regulation 35(5)(a) of the Uncertificated Securities Regulations 2001 (as amended). Unless otherwise instructed, the person appointed as proxy will exercise their discretion as to how they vote or whether they abstain from voting on the resolution and on any other business (including amendments to the resolution and any procedural business, including any resolution to adjourn) which may come before the Court Meeting.

- If this Form of Proxy is returned duly signed but without any indication as to how the person(s) appointed proxy shall vote, they will exercise their discretion as to how they vote and whether or not they abstain from voting.

- Only those Voting Scheme Shareholders registered in the register of members of the Company as at 6.00 p.m. (London, UK time) on 10 November 2025 or, if the Court Meeting is adjourned, 6.00 p.m. (London, UK time) on the day which is two business days before the date of such adjourned meeting will be entitled to attend and/or vote at the Court Meeting in respect of the number of Voting Scheme Shares registered in their name at that time. Changes to entries on the relevant register of shareholders after 6.00 p.m. (London, UK time) on 10 November 2025, or, if the Court Meeting is adjourned, 6.00 p.m. (London, UK time) on the day which is two business days before the date of such adjourned meeting will be disregarded in determining the rights of any person to attend and/or vote at the Court Meeting.

- In the case of joint Voting Scheme Shareholders, any one Voting Scheme Shareholder may vote. If more than one Voting Scheme Shareholder is present at the meeting, or purports to appoint a proxy, only the vote of, or appointment made by, the senior Voting Scheme Shareholder will be accepted, seniority being determined by the order in which the names appear on the register of members of the Company.

- A Voting Scheme Shareholder which is a corporation may authorise a person or persons to act as its representative(s) at the Court Meeting. In accordance with the provisions of the Companies Act 2006, each such representative may exercise (on behalf of the corporation) the same powers as the corporation could exercise if it were an individual Voting Scheme Shareholder, provided that it does not do so in relation to the same Voting Scheme Shares.

- If a Voting Scheme Shareholder appoints a proxy or proxies and then decides to attend the Court Meeting in person and vote on a poll using their poll card, then the vote in person will override the proxy vote(s). If the vote in person is in respect of the Voting Scheme Shareholder's entire holding, then all proxy votes will be disregarded. If, however, the Voting Scheme Shareholder votes at the Court Meeting in respect of less than the Voting Scheme Shareholder's entire holding, and the Voting Scheme Shareholder indicates on their poll card that all proxies are to be disregarded, that shall be the case; but if the Voting Scheme Shareholder does not specifically revoke proxies, then the vote in person will be treated in the same way as if it were the last received proxy and earlier proxies will only be disregarded to the extent that to count them would result in the number of votes being cast exceeding the Voting Scheme Shareholder's entire holding.

- Neither the death nor the incapacity of a Voting Scheme Shareholder who has appointed a proxy, nor the revocation or termination by a Voting Scheme Shareholder of the appointment of a proxy (or of the authority under which the appointment was made), shall invalidate the proxy or the exercise of any of the rights of the proxy thereunder, unless notice of such death, insanity, revocation or termination shall have been either (i) received by the Company at the address specified for receipt of the Forms of Proxy not less than 48 hours before the commencement of the Court Meeting (or adjournment thereof) or (ii) handed to a representative of the Registrar on behalf of the Chairman of the Court Meeting at the Court Meeting before the start of the Court Meeting.

- Any alterations made in this Form of Proxy should be initialled by the person who signs it. You may not use any electronic address provided either in this Form of Proxy, in the notice of the Court Meeting or in any related documents to communicate with the Company for any purposes other than those expressly stated.

- The Court has appointed Richard Fraser or failing him, Mark Holt, or failing him, Elaine Cullen-Grant or, failing them, any other director of the Company to act as Chairman of the meeting and has directed the Chairman to report the result of the Court Meeting to the Court.
